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## IGSSCI PAPER GUIDELINES

1. Paper does not contain any elements of plagiarism.
2. Paper can be a result of research (field or literature), case studies, conceptual or theoretical applications.
3. Typed in:
  - a. Times New Roman font size 12,
  - b. 1.5 line spacing
  - c. A4 size paper with normal margin (TOP: 1" BOTTOM 1" RIGHT: 1" LEFT: 1")
  - d. 12-20 pages including references and tables.
  - e. Microsoft Word (Doc/Docx) or Rich Text Format (rtf).
4. Title, abstract, and key words should all be written in English.
5. The paper is arranged in the following order:
  - a. Title: comprehensive, clear and concise. Title of paper, and title in bold. The title is typed in capital letters size 14.
  - b. The name and address of author: the full name is written without any academic title. If the author is more than one, the full name of ALL authors should be included. Address written under the author's name along with complete address, telephone number and email address that can be contacted.
  - c. Abstract: contains around 250 words, written in a single paragraph.
  - d. key words: listed under abstract with maximum of five words/phrases. Key words should reflect the important concepts that exist in the text.

- e. Paper consists of:
  - i. **INTRODUCTION**
  - ii. **RESULT AND DISCUSSION**
  - iii. **CONCLUSION**
  - iv. **REFERENCE**
- f. **Introduction** (without subtitle and section) contains: background, problem/purpose, literature review, theoretical framework/literature review, materials and methods.
- g. **Results And Discussion:** clearly present and discuss the subject with reference to the purpose of writing.
- h. Images, tables, and formulas: images, tables and formulas are given titles, number, and full description and cited in the text. Tables or images that are too long (more than 1 page) should be avoided. Referral or quoting images, tables and formulas by using numbering, not with words like "below ", or "the following."
- i. Graph or curve: graph or curve that indicates the difference in meaning is made in the form of a line thick/thin/dotted, please avoid using colors to distinguish lines or illustrators.
- j. **Conclusion**
- k. **Reference list**

References are sorted alphabetically and written using APA style.
- l. Do not use foot note
